Offline map (www.msx.org.cn; 2-2 Zhongshan Donglu; 2 admission ¥40, 1 English captions ¥20, free English captions ¥10; 8.30am-7pm; Jianguomen) The National Museum of Modern Art is housed in the first building that Mao Zedong called home in Beijing. Opened in 2000, the museum covers a wide spectrum of modern art from around the world, while the artwork is accompanied by lively English captions. There are five exhibition halls, with the biggest (the Zeng and Shanhui halls) dedicated to modern art and the fifth to contemporary art. Check the online calendar for changing special exhibits. Charing Cross  Offline map Google map (Dongzhimen Bazhu Bowuguan; Offline map; 9112 7777; www.charingcross.org; 19 Dongzhimenwai Dajie; admission ¥40, free English captions; 9am-6pm, last tickets 4pm; Dongzhimen or Jianguomen) Charing Cross is a glass box made of steel and chrome that rises up from the grey riverbank. The current building is the fourth on this site. It serves as a venue for art exhibitions and as a hotel. The building has two towers, one at each end of the site. The upper floors of the central 'Brass Tower' house a bar, a cafe and an exhibition space, while the top floor of the 'Glass Tower' holds the museum. Both towers are connected by a floor-to-ceiling window looking onto a huge piece of water. Charing Cross hosts regular public art exhibitions and installations as well as film festivals and conferences. Beijing Stadium Stadium (Beijing Shijiu Luguan; Offline map; 5 Yongfu Lu) The Olympic Stadium has seats for 100,000 spectators. A retractable roof over the stands increases the capacity to over 200,000. The 82157476af
